### Do you want high speed broadband in Horningsea?

We are stuck with broadband speeds that top out at around 7Mbps at best, and no clear prospect of anything better. (By comparison, South Korea presently has up to 100Mbps, with 1Gbps planned for

2012.) Fruthermore, it's cheaper to get high-speed broadband from an updated exchange (PlusNet, for example, offers up-to-20Mbps on enabled exchanges for £6.49 per month).

If enough people (at least 1,000 residents) vote for **Race For Infinity** it may be possible to get the system upgraded at the Waterbeach exchange. So far there are only 8 votes so far for Waterbeach, so we have some way to go! When it asks "Are you a BT customer?" click 'yes' unless you don't get any services from BT (i.e. you only use Virgin). If you have a copper line coming into your home and you don't use Virgin, you most likely are a BT customer.
