Horticultural Show

The Horticultural Show AGM will be held in the Village Hall on **Tuesday 20th March at 19:30**. All are welcome to attend to find out what it is all about or suggest ideas. New Committee Members are always welcome!

The Show this year is on Saturday 14th July. To celebrate events this summer, the Flower arrangement is "Diamond Jubilee" and all the Photo classes are "Sports".

Work on St Peter's Church – and an extraordinary discovery!

First the bad news: it seems that the cream coloured tiles on the northern aspect of the roof are in a worse condition than had been anticipated. The architects are investigating possible replacement tiles – they need to be handmade, not machine made. The local clay tiles have not lasted so an alternative source is being sought. It may be we can only do a temporary patching job – but that means getting scaffolding back to do the work properly later in the year. All this adds to the cost...

Then the better news: Inside, the plaster has been hacked off the Chancel walls exposing the original stone work. New lime based plaster has been put on. The floor under the choir stall has been rebuilt (previously it was boards resting on bricks resting on bare earth!)

Now the "best" news: When the builders hacked off the plaster they uncovered a medieval door ... call into the Church and have a look!

Note from the police on new 101 number

The Police **101** number for all non-emergency calls was introduced in September 2011, and at the end of March 2012 the old 0345 number will fall out of use. The number change is part of a national scheme to make **101** the single non-emergency number in England and Wales. The system has been designed to recognise where the caller is dialling from and connect them with the local police service. If a caller does not want to speak to their local force they will be given the option to be connected to a different one. People should continue to call 999 when an immediate response is needed because a crime is happening, someone suspected of a crime is nearby, or someone is in danger.
