Operation Twist – online reporting facility

People will be able to report suspicious activity online for the first time. Offenders will often visit an area in the days leading up to a burglary to scope out potential targets. It's at this point that people are most likely to notice something unusual but may not think it is worth reporting. The online reporting facility, 'Operation Twist', offers a way to do this.
