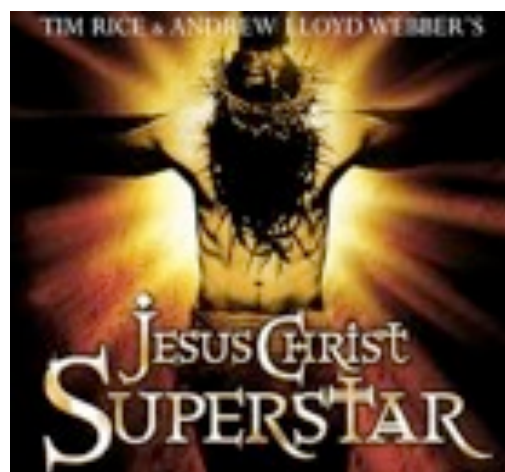


Horningsea 800 plans

HRA Bike Ride

On Sunday the 19th May meet at the Plough and Fleece at 10.30 for the village bike ride.

The route will be easy family riding on roads and cycle paths (a route map will be provided) with "gather-up" points along the way. There will be three routes.

- Short route approx 5 miles (includes crossing at Baits Bite Lock).
- Intermediate route (includes cafe stop) approx 7 miles.
- Optional longer route approx 12 miles.

Riders are expected to ride in a responsible manner in accordance with the Highway Code and parents must be responsible for the safe riding of their children. See you there!

Puppies stolen

POLICE are appealing for information after thieves stole two puppies in South Cambridgeshire. The cocker spaniel puppies were stolen from a house in Station Road, Quy between 10pm on Thursday (April 18) and 7am the following day. The offenders grabbed a golden female and a black male before making off. Detective Sergeant Sarah Gaylor, investigating, said: "If anyone is offered puppies for sale, which are not from a registered breeder and believed to be stolen, to call police. Investigations are underway to determine who has stolen these puppies and I would urge people to report any suspicious activity". More Choice in Social Care

Social care is provided to people who have been assessed as having substantial or critical support needs with personal care, getting meals, managing medication and staying safe. If you need social care the County Council will arrange your care for you, but they now have a duty to offer and provide Direct Payments. Direct Payments are an alternative way of getting the care and support you need. They are cash payments made directly into a Direct Payment bank account so that you can use the money to make your own social care arrangements.

With a Direct Payment you have more choice, control and independence about how your care is organised.
