UPDATE ON FINANCIAL SUPPORT AVAILABLE

We wanted to outline the different types of support that are currently available to residents: see www.scams.gov.uk/coronavirus/help/self-isolation-payment/

- The self-isolation grants offer £500 to people who have been asked to self-isolate and who meet the Government's eligibility criteria
- Grants of £500 are also available to self-isolating people who don't meet the criteria of the above grant, but who meet the criteria of our discretionary scheme
- We are also working with Cambridgeshire County Council to help self-isolating people who do not qualify for the national schemes shown above. These are assessed on a case by case basis so please ask people to get in touch with us via your street coordinator.

Whilst circulating this leaflet, we are following hygiene guidelines but please **wash your hands thoroughly for 20 seconds** with soap and water after handling it.
