#### **UPDATE ON FINANCIAL SUPPORT AVAILABLE**

We wanted to outline the different types of support that are currently available to residents: see www.scambs.gov.uk/coronavirus/help/self-isolation-payment/

- The self-isolation grants offer £500 to people who have been asked to self-isolate and who meet the Government's eligibility criteria
- Grants of £500 are also available to self-isolating people who don't meet the criteria
  of the above grant, but who meet the criteria of our discretionary scheme
- We are also working with Cambridgeshire County Council to help self-isolating people who do not qualify for the national schemes shown above. These are assessed on a case by case basis so please ask people to get in touch with us via your street coordinator.

Whilst circulating this leaflet, we are following hygiene guidelines but please wash your hands thoroughly for 20 seconds with soap and water after handling it.
